ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII, SECTION 5 (A) OF THE WATERTOWN ORDINANCES PROHIBITING THE PLACING, THROWING, PLOWING OR MOVING OF SNOW ONTO THE TOWN'S STREETS OR WAYS

BE IT ORDAINED, that the Town Council of the City known as the Town of Watertown does hereby amend Chapter VII, Section 5 (A), of the Watertown Ordinances as follows:

Delete: "Notwithstanding the foregoing, however, this Ordinance shall not be construed to prohibit owners or lawful occupants of residential premises from placing snow and ice on the sidewalks immediately adjacent to the driveway opening."


Insert in its place: Notwithstanding the foregoing, however, this Ordinance shall not be construed to prohibit owners or lawful occupants of residential premises from placing snow and ice on the sidewalks immediately adjacent to the driveway opening as long as a minimum thirty-six inch (36") wide pathway along the sidewalk is provided for passage within twenty-four hours of snow fall.

This ordinance shall take effect as of July 1, 2003 after adoption by vote of the Town Council.
